U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Reviews Cleanup at Kin-Buc Landfill Site

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is conducting its **5th** Five-Year Review of the **Kin-Buc Landfill Superfund Site** located in the Edison Township, Middlesex County, New Jersey. This review seeks to confirm that the cleanup conducted at the Site, which included: 1) the installation of a slurry wall and landfill cap for source control; 2) groundwater and leachate collection and treatment; 3) long-term groundwater and surface water monitoring; 4) the excavation of sediments with concentrations of polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) greater than 5 parts per million in the Edmonds Creek wetlands; and, 5) wetland restoration, continues to be protective of public health and the environment, and is functioning as designed.

What is an EPA Five-Year Review?

EPA inspects Superfund sites every five years to ensure that cleanups conducted remain fully protective of human health and the environment. These regular reviews, which are required by federal law when contaminants remain at a site, include:

- Inspection of the site and cleanup technologies;
- Review of monitoring data, operating data, and maintenance records, and
- Determination if any new regulatory requirements have been established since EPA's original cleanup decision was finalized.

The five-year review is expected to be completed by the end of March 2019, and the results will be available at the site repository listed below.
