BELOW ARE THE RESPONSES TO THE CURRENT EMAIL AND HOTLINE QUESTIONS REGARDING  
COVID-19

- ALL NON ESSENTIAL SERVICES AND ACTIVITIES ARE CLOSED. THE ORDER OF EXCEPTIONS TO EMPLOYER MANDATES OF CLOSURE IS :

“ All gatherings of persons in the State of New Jersey shall be limited to 50 persons or fewer, excluding normal operations at airports, bus and train stations, medical facilities, office environments, factories, assemblages for the purpose of industrial or manufacturing work, construction sites, mass transit, or the purchase of groceries or consumer goods.”

- THERE IS NOT CURRENTLY AN EXACT NUMBER OF TESTS THAT HAVE BEEN ADMINISTERED IN THE STATE. HOWEVER, IT IS REASONABLE TO ASSUME THAT WITH INCREASED TESTING, WILL BE INCREASED POSITIVE CASES.

- THE PROCEDURE WHEN SOMEONE TESTS POSITIVE WITH COVID-19 IS AS FOLLOWS:
  1. Healthcare provider receives positive result for COVID-19 and reports results to NJ DOH
  2. NJ DOH reports results to Middlesex County DOH
  3. Middlesex County DOH reports result to Edison Health Department
  4. Middlesex County Health Dept. conducts investigation of positive patient who was in “close contact” to others
  5. Middlesex County Health Department will contact those person(s) identified who are at risk because of being in “close contact” and advise what actions to take.
  
- THERE ARE A NUMBER OF STORES IN TOWN THAT ARE TAKING ORDERS ONLINE OR BY PHONE. THESE ORDERS CAN BE PICKED UP AT THE STORE OR DELIVERED TO A LOCATION SUCH AS ONE’S HOME.
