NJMVC Expiration Date Extensions Apply to Commercial Driver Licenses, Commercial Learner Permits, Commercial Registrations, and Temporary Tags

TRENTON – In response to frequent questions, New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission Chief Administrator Sue Fulton today confirmed that the two-month expiration extensions put in place this week for driver licenses, learner permits, and registrations also apply to commercial driver licenses, commercial learner permits, commercial registrations, and temporary tags.

As Chief Fulton announced on Friday, March 13, the extensions were put in place to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 and protect the public.

In addition, currently all NJMVC agencies, road testing and inspection facilities are closed until at least Monday, March 30, 2020.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- The Township of Edison has its Police, Fire and Health Department Personnel enforcing Governor Murphy's Executive Orders regarding COVID-19. Our State is in a Public Health Emergency, and we must have everyone's cooperation. Together we will get through this.

Today, Our Governor and the New Jersey Attorney General stressed that the time for warnings has ended, and enforcement is required.

Enforcement will target businesses and individuals alike. Our Health Inspectors have already commenced visiting the businesses that are regulated by them to ensure full compliance with the emergency orders. They will continue to do this on a daily basis, including weekends, until the restrictions are lifted.

Our Fire Inspectors will continue to conduct their inspections throughout our Township.

Our Police Officers will be patrolling all our commercial, industrial and resident neighborhoods and will take immediate action against any violations observed.

Violations will be issued against the business owners, the homeowners, or an individual; as the particular violation may warrant.
