U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Reviews Cleanup at Chemical Insecticide Corporation Superfund Site

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is conducting its **fifth** Five-Year Review of the **Chemical Insecticide Corporation Superfund Site** located in the Township of Edison, Middlesex County, New Jersey.

This review will address Operable Unit 4 (OU4). OU4 addresses the site-related contaminated groundwater. Operable Unit 1, Operable Unit 2 and Operable Unit 3 have been completed in their entirety and no longer require review.

A summary of OU4 remedial activities and evaluation of the protectiveness of the remedy will be included in the upcoming Five-Year Review report. **The report is scheduled to be completed by 06/28/19.**

What is an EPA Five-Year Review?

EPA inspects Superfund sites every five years to ensure that cleanups conducted remain fully protective of human health and the environment. These regular reviews, which are required by federal law when contaminants remain at a site, include:

- Inspection of the site and cleanup technologies;
- Review of monitoring data, operating data, and maintenance records, and
- Determining if any new regulatory requirements have been established since EPA's original cleanup decision was finalized.
